Telephone Sales or Scams?



The Village of Woodville Utilities Department was recently made aware of residents receiving telephone calls from a company offering to potentially lower their electric supply rate.

These companies are reaching out to all residents within the 419 area code, with a Woodville exchange number (849/567), and/or a 43469 zip code – all of which may apply to Woodville Township and Village residents alike. Township residents do have the option to choose their electric supplier, and Village residents do not. Simply let the caller know that your utilities (water & electric) are provided by your municipality and you cannot participate in their program, and asked to be removed from their call list. Village residents may only choose who provides their natural gas, as we participate in a governmental gas aggregation program.

The Village Utilities Department reminds our customers not to provide credit card numbers or any personal information when receiving suspicious calls from anyone claiming to be affiliated with our utility. If they are demanding payment or threatening utility service disconnection, hang up and contact us immediately at 419-849-2731 or 419-849-3031.
